Internal transfer of appropriations in the 2024 budget of the Euratom Supply Agency

Having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2024/2509 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 September 2024 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012² (hereinafter 'the Financial Regulation'), and in particular Articles 28 and 68 thereof,

Having regard to Commission Decision No C(2023)8660 of 13 December 2023,

Having regard to the budgetary execution of 6 December 2024,

Whereas:

- (1) The Agency intends to reallocate small amounts of money to support upcoming business needs.
- (2) The Agency is committed to implementing the principle of sound financial management.
